August 7, Tuesday, 10:00 to 11:30 am

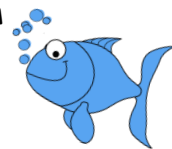
They can whiz past you in the blink of an eye. In this program learn all you want to know about DRAGONFLIES! Fee \$8, members \$6

Nature will provide us with inspiration and some materials to create a variety of craft projects. Fee \$10, members \$7

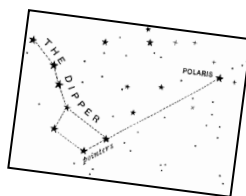
### ZOO DAY!

A hat for sunshade, sunglasses, bug repellent, and sunscreen are also necessary.
